**“Yukon Business”** means a business that complies with the legal requirement to carry on business in the Yukon and must be registered as per the Yukon Business Corporations Act, or the Partnership and Business Name Act and complies with the following criteria for overhead:

- maintains an approved place of business in Yukon by leasing or owning office, commercial or industrial space, or in the case of service oriented businesses, residential space, in the Yukon on an annual basis for the primary purpose of operating the subject business,
- maintains a resident manager, and
- undertakes the majority of its management and administrative functions (related to its operations in Yukon) in Yukon.

**“NND Business”** means a business owned by the NND or by one or more NND Citizens that complies with the legal requirement to carry on business in the Yukon and meets one of the following criteria:

- is a limited company with at least 51 percent of the company's voting shares beneficially owned by one or more NND Citizens;
- is a co-operative with at least 51 percent of the co-operative's voting shares beneficially owned by NND Citizens;
- is a sole proprietorship, the proprietor of which is a NND Citizen;
- is a partnership, the majority interest in which is owned by NND Citizens and in which the majority of benefits, under the partnership agreement, accrues to such NND Citizens; or
- is a limited company, partnership or joint venture in which a NND Business on its own or in conjunction with an aboriginal business holds a controlling right or share and complies with the following criteria for overhead:
  - maintains an approved place of business in Yukon by leasing or owning office, commercial or industrial space, or in the case of service oriented businesses, residential space, in Mayo, Yukon on an annual basis for the primary purpose of operating the subject business,
  - maintains a resident manager, and
  - undertakes the majority of its management and administrative functions (related to its operations in Yukon) in Yukon.
