MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN - MILLWRIGHT

Under the direction of the Fixed Supervisor, the Millwright is responsible for maintaining all mechanical planned and unplanned repairs to the equipment. To repair the routine, emergency repairs of all fixed maintenance equipment. To maintain, with the highest standard of safety across the mine-site. This position will work on a rotational basis (2x2). Responsibilities are noted below which will include but are not limited to:

Main Tasks and Responsibilities:

- Conducting preventative maintenance and servicing of fixed equipment.

- Rebuilding components and working with manufacturers when necessary.
- Documenting and returning all completed work orders in a timely manner.

- Provide input and work collaboratively with Planners and Schedulers to develop work packages.
