MINE TRAINER

Under the direction of the Senior Training Coordinator, the Mine Trainer is responsible for ensuring all personnel are adequately trained and all documentation is accounted for and maintained. This position will work on a rotational basis, two weeks on-site with two weeks of leave (2x2). Responsibilities are noted below which will include but are not limited to:

Main Tasks and Responsibilities:

- Safety of self and others.
- Train mine operations employees on equipment.
- Train maintenance employees on safe movement and function testing of Mine Operations equipment, and all support equipment.
- Train crushing, conveying and Heap Leach employees on all related equipment and systems.
- Use of equipment simulator and CBT programs as part of training curriculum.
- Completion of all documentation related to all training must be completed and maintained.
- Operating and training experience on support equipment: Rough Terrain Forklift, Counter Balanced Forklift, Skid Steer Loader, Elevated Work Platform, Overhead Crane.
- Coordinate training with other departments and operations including tracking schedule compliance, reviewing completed training and prioritizing training to be completed.
