- Work in cooperation with the site environmental group to ensure compliance with all site regulations and permits
- Provide safe working conditions and ensure that all safety concerns are addressed
- Ensure safe & efficient operation of all processing facilities
- This position will be responsible for certain areas & personnel as assigned but can be directly responsible for up to 4 shifters and indirectly responsible for up to 35+ process employees
- Ensure priorities are established in order of importance for production purposes
- Accountable for effective communication with superiors, maintenance groups as well as others
- Fill in for Process superintendent as required
