Paramedic/Safety Technician

Under the direction of the Health, Safety & Manager, the PCP - Paramedic/Safety Technician will be responsible for providing First Aid / Medical support for both work and non-work related injuries and illnesses while practicing within his or her scope of practice and direction from Victoria Gold’s Medical Director. This position will work a rotational basis, two weeks on-site with two weeks of leave (2x2). Responsibilities will include but are not limited to:

Main Tasks and Responsibilities:

- Provide emergency first aid services and coordinate transport of critically ill or injured personnel
- Manage the day-to-day operation of the first aid clinic for both work and non-work related cases
- Coordinate with the Medical Director on matters related to medical support and preventative health programs
- Manage, organize, and secure medical records.
- Participate in the administration of the site alcohol and drug screening program
- Participate on the Emergency Response Team during training and in the event of emergencies
- Participate in various aspects of the Work Place Monitoring program
- Facilitate first aid training
- Work closely with management to ensure that programs and initiatives are consistent with industry best practice and regulatory requirements, and that programs and initiatives are rigidly adhered to
- Provide support regarding HS&S related inspections, investigations, security, and reporting requirements
