Under the direction of the Health, Safety and Security Manager, the Health Safety and Security Coordinator is responsible for ensuring that operational and support area management are pro-actively and consistently adhering to industry best practices and regulatory requirements to ensure the safety of the entire workforce and contracting body at Eagle Mine. Responsibilities are noted below which will include but are not limited to:

Main Tasks and Responsibilities:

- Safety of self and others;
- Manage and ensure all employees and contractors are working in compliance with all VGC Eagle, Territorial and Federal safety guidelines and procedures and adherence to applicable laws, rules and regulations;
- Interface with Territorial and Federal regulatory agencies;
- Manage training and audit schedules for ERT and CEMP;
- Manage the HS&S Observation Program, conduct and document field audits and follow up on actions/suggestions;
- Coordinate inspections and complaint visits with area supervisors and miner’s representatives;
- Assist with the development and review procedures;
- Participate in Joint Occupational Safety and Health Committee activities as required;
- Provide guidance regarding HS&S related inspections, investigations and reporting requirements;
- Develop and manage the Contractor Safety Program and participate in pre-qualification of contract companies;
- Participate in the inspection of contractor equipment;
- Attend department daily/weekly meetings, HS&S meetings and training classes;
- Track and report trends to improve the safety and health of employees;
- Provide guidance and recommendations on site security matters;
- Stay abreast of proposed and pending Health & Safety laws, regulations, enforcement trends and opportunities that that could affect the Eagle Mine; and,
- Behave in a way that demonstrates support of Victoria Gold’s Vision and Values.
