SITE SERVICES OPERATOR

Under the direction of the Site Services Supervisor, the Site Services Operator is responsible for safely and efficiently operating a variety of support equipment including dozers, graders, vac truck, skid steer, zoom boom, excavator, and front-end loaders. This position will be based at the Eagle Gold Mine-site working a rotational schedule; 12 hours per shift on a day/night shift work schedule.
